

Scotch Doubles Guidelines

Partners 2020 Scotch Doubles Fall League Guidelines

1. League begins Monday, September 21, 2020, runs for 10 weeks and ends Monday, November 30, 2020. No play is scheduled for the Stat Holidays, Thanksgiving and Remembrance Day.
2. Each team will play two matches once each week. Play is to start at 6:30 pm on weeknights and 12:00 noon on Saturdays. Please come a few minutes early and be ready to start play at the scheduled time. Play can start at 6:00 pm if both teams agree to the earlier start time.
3. If a player is not ready to play when it is their turn, the other team can announce the start of a time limit. The clock starts and the missing player is given 2 minutes to become ready to play. If the missing player is not ready to play at the end of the 2 minutes, the game is a forfeit. The team of the missing player receives a "0" score and the other team gets a "10" score but no personal stat is awarded (like a 10-zip, etc.). This rule is enforced even if only one of the captains wants to use it.
4. Please fill in and keep a stub end of a score sheet. This is YOUR record of who has paid and how much each player has paid AND the scores your team has earned. Compare your records to the statistics and payment records, which are on the web site and posted at each bar. If you think a mistake has been made, please phone Christine Thomas (403) 850-4188.
5. There are two people per team, one male and one female.
6. The Team Fee is \$20.00 per team per week (\$200.00 for the session). This fee allows Playoff entrance, league stats, Playoff winnings, and a CCS membership for each player.
7. No subs are allowed. Each team must have the same two players for each week/match.
8. 80% of all games must be played via regularly scheduled games or make up games. There are 20 games per session, therefore, 4 games can be missed and the team will still qualify for the playoffs if all fees are paid in full (\$200.00). If a default is declared, the defaulting team receives a -0- score and the other team receives a 50 score. No personal/extra stats are awarded.
9. Fees and all fines must be paid in full by Monday, November 30, 2020. Teams are expected to keep fees paid up to date.
10. Only teams paid in full can play in the Playoffs.
11. All Team Fees must be paid in full by Monday, November 30, 2020, whether or not the games have been played.
12. We have a five-person Committee to resolve special circumstances and set precedence:

13. The Playoffs are a Double Elimination Format.
14. No Coaching ... teammates can talk to each other only when the other team is shooting. Not when it is their team's turn to shoot.
15. Either player can call a foul against the other team when the other team is playing.
16. The female team members lag for home team position. Home team gets 3 breaks, away team gets 2 breaks.
17. Either team member can break. Can also be the same person every time a team has the break.
18. Make up games are ok.
19. No handicaps are used.
20. Each Monday, each team will play 5 racks against one team and then 5 racks against another team.
21. A point system will be used for scoring. 1 point for each object ball sunk and 3 points for the 8 ball.
22. Extra points are awarded as follows: 1/2 pt for an ERO, 1/2 pt for a Ten-Zip, 1 pt for each rack won, 1 pt for highest total score, and, 1 pt for a 50 score. Please add these extra points at the end of your scoresheet.
23. The prize money is awarded based on the results of the playoffs and is as follows:

24. The following must be filled in on the score sheets: First and Last Names, dates, team names and points earned and total scores.
25. Playing schedules for Scotch Doubles are posted at Partners #1 and Partners #2, and, on the website www.partnerspubs.ca
26. Make up match deadline is Monday, November 30, 2020.
27. Make up matches must be played exactly as originally scheduled. Each team must play against the team indicated on the make up game list.

28. If your team is unable to play on a league night please contact the opposing team at least 24 hours ahead of time. This gives the other captain time to notify his/her team's players that the match has been postponed and that a make up match is to be scheduled.

29. Team contact lists are posted at Partners #1 and #2 and on the web site www.partnerspubs.ca

30. If you do not give the other team 24 hours notice, the team that shows up is entitled to accept a forfeit and all the points. The missing team receives a "0" score and the other team gets a "10" score but no personal stat is awarded (like a 10-zip, etc.). To arrange make up matches please contact Trish Gailleonardo (403) 607-8384

If forfeited, both teams must pay the appropriate fees for all matches whether actually played or won/lost by default.

31. Please use the CCS and World Pool-Billiard Association (WPA) Rules and these guidelines. <http://www.cdnqsport.com/worldrules.aspx> Please remember that our Partners Pool League Guidelines take precedence over these other guidelines.

32. If the two teams in need of a make up match are unable to agree on a date and time then a date and time will be assigned by the Committee.

33. Each team is allowed to accumulate 2 unplayed make up matches at a time and is expected to schedule and play make up matches within 2 weeks of each missed game. If not made up within 2 weeks, the Committee will decide when and where it is to be played. If the Committee scheduled make up game is not played as scheduled there will be a \$50.00 per team fine and the Committee will decide how the points are distributed.

34. If a make up match has been arranged by the teams and only one team shows up, the team that shows up must call a Committee member immediately from the bar. The manager on duty will verify which team members have shown up. The team that did show up will submit a score sheet with the names and I.D. numbers of their players. The team that did not show up will receive a \$50.00 fine and the Committee will decide how the points are distributed. Both teams must pay the appropriate fees for all make up matches whether actually played or won/lost by default.

35. The \$50.00 fines will be added to the prize fund. Failure to pay any fines or Team Fees means your team will not play in the Playoffs.

37. The Home Team record is considered the correct record during league play and the Playoffs. The Away Team should compare their records to the Home Team records regularly. During league play it is highly recommended to compare records after each round but should be considered mandatory during Playoffs.

During the Playoffs the Away Team should check the Home Team scoresheet to verify the correct scores before the next round begins. If it isn't checked and the following round begins, all prior discrepancies are dismissed and the Home Team's record stands.

38. In the event the Total Points are tied during the Playoffs, the last rack will be played again.

39. Whenever a player requests someone to witness a shot, in addition to that witness, the referee or another person will take a slow-motion video of the shot. The slow-motion video can be used to correctly identify the legality of the shot. If a referee is available, then the referee and the shooters will watch the video and the referee will determine the legality of the shot. If no referee is available, then the witness and the shooters will watch the video. The witness will determine the legality of the shot.

39. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. The Committee has the option to suspend or disqualify players and/or teams for unsportsmanlike behavior. If you witness any unsportsmanlike comments or actions, please report them to the Committee a.s.a.p.

40. Kidnapping of any player(s) from any other team(s) during the Playoffs will result in the kidnappers' team being disqualified from the Playoffs.
